Every year Institute of Banking Personnel Selection holds the IBPS clerical cadre in multiple Public Sector banks. IBPS started Common Written Examination (CWE) in the year 2011 to recruit officers and clerks in Public Sector Banks. It accepts online application through its official website for registration of the examination.

It is held at various locations throughout India. The mode of examination is online. In 2017, IBPS CWE-VII Clerk Pre-Exam is held on 2nd, 3rd, 09th and 10th December. IBPS Clerk Main Examination will be held on 21 January 2018.

IBPS Clerk Notification 2017

IBPS has announced official notification of IBPS Clerk. The Online Registration for IBPS Clerk is from 12 September to 03 October 2017. IBPS has introduced 7883 vacancies for IBPS Clerk 2017 Exam.

The candidates eligible and interested can register themselves online for the said post on the official IBPS website. www.ibps.in

IBPS Clerk Exam Centre

The IBPS Clerk exam (CWE) is held online at various centres all over India and the candidates can mention their options at the time of filling in the online application. Though there is non-availability of seats at preferred venues yet IBPS allots an exam centre other than the choices made by a candidate.

IBPS is the only authority to add or remove an exam centre. The candidates can't make any request for the change of the exam centre. Any indecent behaviour at the examination centre can lead to cancellation of the application.

Selection Procedure

The selection process of IBPS Clerk consists of 2 phases (preliminary and mains). The candidates must qualify each of them to go on to the next phase.

The important steps of the IBPS Clerk Recruitment Procedure are as follows:

- **Online Preliminary Examination:**

Sufficient number of candidates in each category is shortlisted by IBPS depending upon the requirements for Online Main Examination

- **Online Mains Examination:**

Candidates need to qualify each section as well as the overall cut-off in the main exam to be eligible for the Final Selection.

- **Final Result:**

The Final result is declared on the basis of merit list in IBPS Clerk Mains Exam.

- **Provisional Allotment:**

The provisional allotment of the eligible candidate is released on the official website. The IBPS allots Banks to the candidates on the basis of the preferences they have made at the time of the online registration.

IBPS plays its role in the selection process till the provisional selection to different banks. Further the responsibility to inform the qualified candidates about their joining dates and procedure lies with the respective banks.

IBPS Clerk Exam Pattern

The IBPS Clerk exam (CWE 7) for hiring candidates will be held online. The exam will be in two parts: Preliminary and Mains. IBPS Clerk Prelims Exam Pattern

The IBPS Clerk preliminary examination is of one hour duration and is conducted online. It has 3 sections with having 100 questions in total with a maximum score of 100 marks. There is negative marking in IBPS Clerk Pre exam as 0.25 marks are deducted for every wrong answer. Candidates must clear the sectional cut-off to qualify for the IBPS Clerk Main exam. The section-wise details are given below:

IBPS Clerk Mains Exam Pattern

The exam pattern of IBPS Clerk Mains is also changed. Main exam is also held online, the latest update by IBPS it has 4 sections there is 190 Question having a total score of 200 marks of 160 minutes duration. Last Year Computer Aptitude and Reasoning Ability section conduct Separately, but in the recent update both section comes together have 50 question and time duration is 45 minutes.

The candidates must attempt the sections in the same order and within the allotted time fixed by the examining body. The candidate can't leave the existing section before the time allotted. The next section can only be attempted after the current section is completed. There is a negative marking with a deduction of 0.25 marks for every mistake.

Penalty for Wrong Answers:

A penalty for every incorrect answer will be marked in the Objective Tests of both Preliminary and Mains exams. Every wrong answer will be penalized by deducting 0.25 of the marks assigned to that question. There will be no penalty for leaving a question blank, i.e. in case no answer is marked by the candidate.

Final Score Calculation for IBPS Clerk Exam:

There are certain important points on the basis of which the final score for the IBPS Clerk exam is calculated:

- Marks scored in the Preliminary Exam (Tier-1) will not be considered in the final score. These are only taken into account to qualify Mains Exam (Tier-2).
- Candidates need to qualify Phase-2 and Interview individually to be eligible for final worth.

- The aggregate of 100 marks is used for the final merit list for each category. Candidates with high merit rank in each category are finally selected.

IBPS Clerk Syllabus 2017

IBPS exam syllabus is similar to other bank exams except that IBPS issues only the broad subjects, they can be further bifurcate into individual topics, based on the questions that have appeared in the exams over the past few years. The IBPS syllabus is divided into two parts:

IBPS Clerk Mains Exam Syllabus 2017

This year the exam pattern of IBPS Clerk Mains is changed. Main exam is also held online, the latest update by IBPS it has 4 sections there is 190 Question having a total score of 200 marks of 160 minutes duration. Last Year Computer Aptitude and Reasoning Ability section conduct Separately, but in the recent update both section comes together have 50 question and time duration is 45 minutes.

IBPS Clerk Eligibility Criteria - 2017

Educational Qualification

Graduation Degree: The eligibility criteria for the IBPS CWE exam is graduation degree in any of the streams such as BA, B.Com, BSc, B.Tech, etc., from a University recognized by the Government of India. Candidate who possesses same qualification from the university recognized by the Central Government is also eligible to apply for this exam.

Candidates should have a valid Mark-sheet / Degree:

Certificate which supports that they are graduates on the day they were registered for the exam.

The percentage of marks obtained in Graduation should be mentioned at time of registration for the IBPS Bank-Clerk examination.

Computer Literacy: Knowledge of computer operation is a must as IBPS Clerk exam is conducted online.

Language Proficiency: Candidates should have verbal and written proficiency in official language of the State/UT. The candidate should be able to read, write and speak the language.

Nationality / Citizenship of Applicants:

Candidates applying for IBPS CWE/Bank Clerk Examination should be one of the following:

1. Citizen of India
 2. Subject of Nepal or Bhutan
 3. Tibetan Refugee who came to India before 1st January 1962 with the intention of permanent settlement
 4. Person of Indian Origin (PIO) who has migrated from Burma, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Vietnam or East African countries of Zaire, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Ethiopia, Malawi, with the intention of permanent settlement in India
- Candidates belonging to the category 2, 3, 4 must have a certificate of eligibility issued by the Govt of India in their favour.

Age Eligibility of candidates applying for IBPS Bank Clerk Examination:

Candidates applying for the IBPS CWE examination should be of 20 years old but not more than 28 years old at the time of registration. Besides this, there is age relaxation relevant to category wise candidates as per the government rules:

IBPS Clerk Pre-Exam Training

The Nodal Banks/ Participating Organizations may organize pre-examination training for SC/ST/Religious Minority Community candidates at certain centres as per the strategy issued by Government of India. This is a kind of training session where candidates are acquainted with the type of questions, common mistakes, and tips for time management, best practices, basic tricks and approaches by experts from training organizations. The purpose is to give a level playing field to students from weaker sections that can't afford coaching and make them aware about general facet and recruitment procedure of the exam.

Candidates belonging to above-mentioned categories can undergo training by signifying the same against relevant column, at the time of applying on-line.

The pre-exam training is free of cost with other expenses like travel, food and lodging expenses are incurred by the candidate. Generally, it is conducted for five days before the exam and the dates are announced on the official website. Please find below a

Salary of IBPS PO

In the majority of the public sector banks, Salary of Clerk is more or less the same. The latest revision of Bank Clerk salary as per 10th Bipartite settlement, took place on Nov 2012; nonetheless the final agreement was signed in May 2015.

The revised basic pay of Clerk thus becomes –

Here Rs. 21990 is the revised basic pay of Bank clerk as applicable on 1st January 2016. Thus the new entrant in a Bank as Clerk is liable to get Rs. 21,990 as basic pay and salary in hand 19590.
